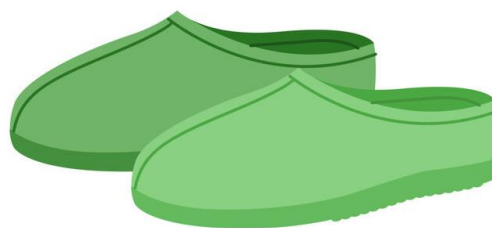
After School Clubs
